



POOL USE RULES

Published – June, 2017

- The Timberlane Pool is for Members, Residents and their guests.
- The Pool Rules will be enforced by the Pool Staff and apply to all members, adults and children alike.
- The pool staff has the authority to enforce any rules not listed to maximize the safety and enjoyment of pool patrons.
- These Rules are approved by the Board of Directors.

USE RULES:

- 1) **No lifeguard on duty.** All persons using the pool do so at their own risk in conformance with the Rules.
- 2) Children age 12 & under must be accompanied by an adult age 18 & over.
- 3) Swimmers between the age of 13 & 17 must not use the pool alone.
- 4) Everyone must shower before using the pool.
- 5) Adults are exempt from showering if they will not be entering the water.
- 6) Adults may wear street clothes over swim wear, if they are supervising their children from the deck.
- 7) Swim diapers must be used at all times & must be changed in the restroom in designated changing area.
- 8) If you have a disease that can be transmitted by water or have been ill with diarrhea or vomiting in the last 2 weeks, do not use the pool.
- 9) Swimmers with seizure, heart or circulatory problems should not swim alone.
- 10) No running or rough play.
- 11) No alcohol.
- 12) No food or drinks (except water in a non-breakable, sealable container).
- 13) No smoking.
- 14) Persons failing to follow rules are subject to removal from the premises.
- 15) Proper swimwear only. No cutoffs. No street clothes. A plain white t-shirt or tank tops is allowed.
- 16) All long hair must be tied back or braided with a rubber band, no hair scrunchies.
- 17) The following will not be allowed on the pool deck or pool bathrooms:
 - a) No Pets, hairdryers, bad language, horseplay, running, pushing, and chewing gum.
 - b) No Diving in the shallow end (0-5 feet deep).
- 18) Goggles are o.k. Approved facemasks only. No snorkels, and no fins.
- 19) The pool phone is to be used only for office business and emergencies. If you plan on picking up your children, please make prior arrangements with them.
- 20) The Pool Staff is not responsible for personal belongings.
- 21) No birthday parties.
- 22) Last admittance will be 30 minutes before closing.

DEFINITIONS:

- A **Member** – is a Timberlane Homeowner whose dues are current.
- A **Resident** – is a Timberlane homeowner or renter.
- A **Member in Good Standing** is a member of the Timberlane HOA whose dues and fines are paid in full and whose membership privileges have not been revoked.
- An **Adult** - A person 18 years of age or older.
- The **Pool Staff** are official representative of the Timberlane HOA whose function is to enforce all the HOA pool use rules within the pool area.
